The men's group will meet on Tuesday, November 11th for the first part of the **3-part video series on**

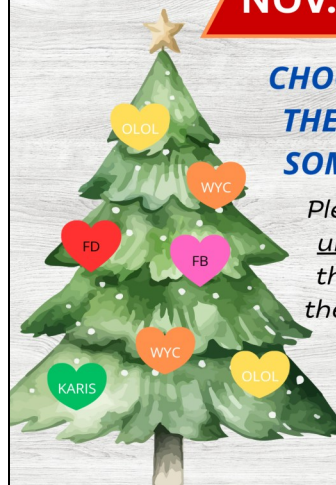

The use of **tobacco**, vapour products and cannabis (all forms) is banned on all public and private Kindergarten to Grade 12 schools in **British Columbia**. The **ban** extends to all school property 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, regardless of whether or not school is in session. The ban also includes parking lots, driveways, courtyards, private vehicles parked on school property and areas abutting school property. **Violations of smoke and vapour free legislation could result in a fine for the owner, manager, lessee and/or person smoking or vaping.**

As per guidelines from the Diocese of Nelson all Churches and properties are also non smoking.
