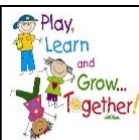

### **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS**

### THE IMPORTANCE OF DRESSING FOR THE OCCASION

According to the Conference of Catholic Bishops, those attending Mass should be "appropriately dressed", which means clothing "should not be excessively elaborate or revealing" (no cut-off shorts, tank tops, crop tops and ball caps).

Although there are no official rules about what to wear in Church, "smart casual" or "business casual" are greatly acceptable dress codes when putting together an outfit for Sunday mass. Some people make it easy for themselves by following a job interview dress code. If you would not wear it to a job interview, you probably should not wear it to church.

With the hotter summer weather here in West Kelowna, please be mindful of your attire in attending the Eucharistic Celebration. Thank you, everyone, for your help in making the Holy Mass a truly prayerful experience for everyone!
